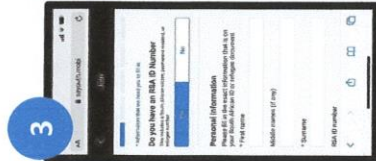

This screen appears when you visit sayouth.mobi. If you have already registered with SA Youth, Harambee Youth Employment Accelerator or Tshepo 1 Million you can just click LOGIN. Forgotten your password? Click the FORGOT PASSWORD button. Not yet registered with any of these organisations? Click "Join the Network"



The next page tells you what you need to complete your registration and tells you how long it will take – it shouldn't take more than 4 minutes



You can use your ID number to register - however if you do not have an ID number you can still register on the system



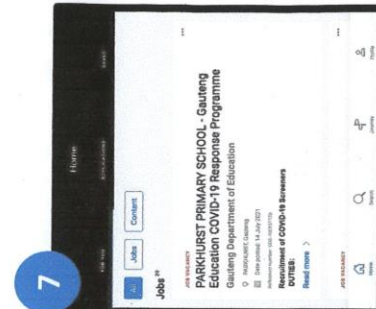
Once your registration is complete, a list of jobs available in your area will come up including the Opportunity Cards for the schools that are closest to you. ONLY apply at schools that you are easily able to walk to every day. NEXT STEP: click the "Read more" button



You can then read more about the details of the job opportunity. If you are interested in this opportunity all you need to do is click the "Apply now" button




Once you have applied you will see this screen confirming that your application has been successful. Please make sure you keep your phone switched on, charged and close to you until 24 October 2021. If you are shortlisted for the opportunity you will be contacted via SMS or phone call by the school



If you are contacted for an interview you will be asked to bring the following documentation with you:

1. Certified copy of your ID
2. Matric certificate (if required for the role) or other NQF4 or higher proof of qualification
3. Your CV
4. A testimonial letter (eg. From a former school, local chief, church leader or previous employer)

 If you do not see the school that is closest to you on the list of opportunities: Click the **SEARCH** button at the bottom of the screen and search for the name of the school (note that NOT all schools in the country are participating). Once you have found the school, apply for the relevant position and complete the questions you are asked.

Which schools are included in the programme?	<p>Public Ordinary Schools & Learners with Special Educational Needs (LSEN) schools in 9 Provincial Education Departments (PED's)</p> <p>Some schools may choose not to participate in the programme</p>
How many opportunities are there per school?	<p>There will be a minimum of 10 / 15 assistants allocated per school depending on the size of the school.</p>
Who should apply?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Aged 18-35 (must not turn 36 before 31 March 2022 - except for LSEN schools where there is no age limit) • Must live walking distance from the location of the school • Only one opportunity can be taken up per household • Must not be employed, studying or training (even part time) • Must NOT be receiving government grants (NSFAS, Funza Lushaka). <p>How do young people apply for the positions? Can I walk into a school and apply?</p>	<p>There is only one way to apply for this opportunity and walk-ins to the schools are discouraged Go to www.sayouth.mobi (zero rated) and register. Once you have registered you will be able to apply to a school near to where you live on the mobi site.</p> <p>You cannot apply by visiting the school in person – if young people are not on the SA Youth system they will not be able to be paid.</p>
<p>I was a part of the previous DBE opportunity in 2020. I performed well at my school - do I need to reapply or will I automatically get my job back?</p>	<p>Everyone needs to re-apply for these positions regardless of whether or not they have worked in this role before.</p> <p>You can apply to the school where you previously worked. If you performed well this will obviously count in your favour in the interview.</p>



<p>When will they hear back if they have been successful?</p>	<p>If you have not heard back from a school by 24 October 2021 then unfortunately your application has not been successful.</p>
<p>Once I have registered on sayouth.mobi how do I apply?</p>	<p>Once you have registered on the site - the DBE opportunities that match your location will appear automatically. Alternatively you can search under "Education Assistant" or "General School Assistant" & find an opportunity close to you.</p> <p>PLEASE NOTE: if you apply for a position that you live too far away from to walk to, your application will not be successful. ONLY apply to opportunities that you are able to walk to every morning.</p>
<p>The mobi-site says that I am already registered on the site but I have never registered?</p>	<p>If you have previously registered on harambee.mobi or on tshepo.mobi you will automatically be registered on sayouth.mobi. So just log in using those details. If you can't remember your password select the option "Forgot password" and if you are using the phone number that you used when you originally registered you will receive a link via SMS to reset your password.</p> <p>If you have changed your phone number you will need to use your email address to reset it. Otherwise you can call 0800 727272 for help re-setting your password. (Please note that over this time we will be receiving a LOT of phone calls so you need to be patient)</p>
<p>I am having trouble applying on the SA Youth mobi-site, what do I do?</p>	<p>Thanks for your patience, there are a lot of young people all applying at the same time - which causes the mobi-site to go down occasionally. We are working on it all the time to make sure you can access it. Remember you have until 3rd October to apply so please try again later!</p> <p>SAYouth.mobi is zero rated but still requires a connection so if you struggle to access the site you can also try from another phone or device (perhaps a friend or family member).</p> <p>If you are struggling to access as you have forgotten your password, you can reset via the SAYouth mobi site, using the following steps:</p> <p>Step 1: Go to the login page and find link to 'I forgot my username / password',</p> <p>Step 2: Choose your recovery method.</p> <p>SMS - To use the SMS option you must have access to the phone number used to set up your account and either your SA ID number or your full name. if the profile details match you will receive an SMS with a reset link within 1 hour, select the link in this SMS to set your new password.</p> <p>EMAIL - If you'd prefer to reset via email, you will follow similar steps but you will need to have access to the email address you used to set up the account, once entered you will receive your reset link via email. enter your details, wait for a reset link to be sent to you via SMS or Email,</p> <p>SECURITY QUESTIONS - or you can reset using security questions if you set these up previously.</p>

How will I know if my application was received?	Once you apply, the mobi site will display a message saying that your application has been received. This is your confirmation - plus if you try to apply again it will tell you that you have already applied.
How do I know if my application is successful?	Those shortlisted for an interview at a school (these are not "successful applicants" but rather shortlisted applicants) will be contacted by the relevant school (not by SA Youth) to invite them to an interview. Once young people have applied – they must not contact SA Youth to ask if they have been successful. The interview and selection process will be managed by the schools - NOT by SA Youth.
What documents do I have to supply and when / how do I supply it? How are people being shortlisted?	Applicants are shortlisted based on their eligibility: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Matching the criteria (age, qualification) • Proximity to school • Community involvement
What happens if I don't live near the schools that I applied for and get shortlisted?	If you misrepresented your address and proximity to the school you will be terminated with immediate effect. So please make sure that the address details listed on SA Youth are correct!

<p>The toll-free number is just ringing, no one is answering, is it working?</p>	<p>Our toll free support line is open 9am-4.30pm if you are struggling to get through we may be experiencing higher than normal call volumes. Please note you can apply for this opportunity, update your profile & reset your password yourself through SAyouth.mobi.</p> <p>You can also chat to us via our SA Youth Facebook page or send us an email via support@sayouth.org.za</p>
<p>I applied on Moya App, Tshepo 1Million & not SA Youth Mobi, will my application be considered?</p>	<p>Yes, you can apply on SA Youth, Harambee or on Tshepo 1 Million but only SA Youth is zero rated so it won't use any of your data.</p>
<p>Will the successful applicants be vaccinated?</p>	<p>It is preferred that all successful applicants are vaccinated before they start in the schools. Applicants are all in the age bracket that are eligible for the vaccine and should visit a vaccine site closest to them to get the vaccine.</p>
